

## Virginia Association for Career & Technical Education (January 9, 2026 Legislative Report)

The General Assembly will gavel in for the 2026 Regular Legislative session on Wednesday, January 14. Over the last week, hundreds of bills have been trickling in as the Division of Legislative Services continues to draft and file bills for legislators. Bill pre-filing officially ends 10:00am January 14. The final deadline to introduce 'regularly' filed bills is 3:00pm Friday, January 23. This is an 'even-number' year, and therefore a long 60-day session. With an even number year, it also marks the beginning of consideration for a new state biennium for FY27 & FY28.

Below you will find a list of bills, as of today, that may be of interest. We will continue to monitor filed legislation hourly. This year, following the recent general election for all 100 members of the House of Delegates, the Democrats have a new 64-36 seat House majority, while still maintaining their one-seat majority in the Senate. The Senate of Virginia will also have a Democratic Lt. Governor presiding over the chamber as President of the Senate and a tie-breaking vote. With the addition of a new Democratic Governor, this new political makeup in Richmond is being called the Democrat Trifecta, with the party controlling the House, Senate, and executive branch.

This year, we can expect to see legislative themes centered around affordability, wages, housing, workforce-preparedness, healthcare, and several hyper-partisan issues the past administration has vetoed. Every week this session we will be providing a written report highlighting both specific legislation of interest, as well as a general overview of the current political climate in Richmond. We will also continue to update you on where we are in the bill process.
